Bowls England National Competitions are go!

Each year, Bowls England, the governing body of lawn bowls, hold their annual National Competitions.

Any member of an affiliated club may enter. There are no requirements to qualify, apart from the 'Champion of Champions' competition. And to enter this, you must be the winner of your club singles. Both Christine Poulter and Andy Lowe will be Hook Bowls Club entries for the 2026 season, after both winning the club singles in 2025.

This year, Vicky Hodges and Brenda Grout have entered the 'Foundation Pairs'. This competition was introduced last year to encourage bowlers to enter external competitions. The criteria being that one player must have bowled for less than five years; and the other must never have reached the Bowls England final.

Vicky will be entering her 3rd season outdoors in 2026 and Brenda has been bowling for many years and brings a wealth of knowledge, experience and steady encouragement to less experienced bowlers.

The 'Foundation Pairs' competition is a game of three bowl pairs, played over two sets of nine ends. A point given for each set won, with a one end tie break if the score at the end of the sets is tied.

Our club also enter teams each year, usually into the 'Tony Alcock' competition which is a game of two rinks (four in a team) for the over 60s and the 'Open Two Fours' competition which has no age limits.

The Bowls England National Competitions portal opened on **the 1st December**. It is a simple process to enter. Although you may not get to the finals, I can assure you, you'll learn a lot and the more you know the more you will enjoy.

So for anyone thinking about it, why not have a go and enter yourself into one of these competitions. The Club will support you and it's a great experience.

World Bowls Series Finals

The World Bowls Series Finals, held at ‘cluBarham’, New South Wales, Australia from 10–12 December, delivered three days of top-tier international competition featuring the world’s highest-ranked singles players.

Bowls England’s squad produced an excellent showing, particularly in the women’s event, where Nicole Rogers (pictured) and Emily Kernick dominated Section 2 to secure both semi-final places. Rogers topped the group with confident performances, while Kernick followed closely behind to advance.

In the men’s competition, Sam Tolchard and Dominic McVittie both battled strongly through a difficult sectional draw, each finishing with six points and narrowly missing out on progression. Their performances underscored England’s competitive depth at the elite level.

While no titles were secured this year, England’s consistent presence in the knockout stages - especially with two women’s semi-finalists, highlighted a highly successful campaign and a promising platform for the 2026 World Bowls Series season.

Australian based Ulsterman Gary Kelly (NI) and Dawn Hayman (AUS) (pictured) were crowned champions.

Rogers took the Silver medal and Kernick the Bronze in the ladies section.
